The USAID-funded Pakistan Reading Project is introducing its Mobile Library Program to meet the challenge of access to quality reading material and library services, particularly for children living in far-flung areas, in Sindh and Islamabad Capital Territory (ICT).

Our mobile libraries will carry a carefully selected collection of English and Urdu books endorsed by the National Library of Pakistan and the National Book Foundation. Each bus will also have a trained librarian who will not only manage the books, maintain logs, and recommend reading material for various ages and interests, but will also receive feedback from readers and act as a storyteller for gathered audiences in the communities the bus visits. This program aims to stimulate the joy of reading and provide access to quality reading material, which in turn will help in promoting and encouraging a habit of reading.

The USAID-funded Pakistan Reading Project is a five-year initiative supporting Pakistan's provincial and regional Departments of Education to improve the reading skills of children in primary schools across the country.
